


Venezuela





The Church of the Nazarene began work in Venezuela in 1982. The beginnings of the work in the country were unique. Before the church in Venezuela was organized, there were Nazarenes in the country because of the radio ministry “La Hora Nazarena” (The Nazarene Hour). Venezuela is a country on the northern coast of South America with diverse natural attractions. Along its Caribbean coast are tropical resort islands including Isla de Margarita and the Los Roques archipelago. The population is approximately 28.44 million and the official language is Spanish.



“We had never had an experience like this,” said one of the volunteers. “There were always five or six people out to evangelize, but yesterday all the churches did it together.”

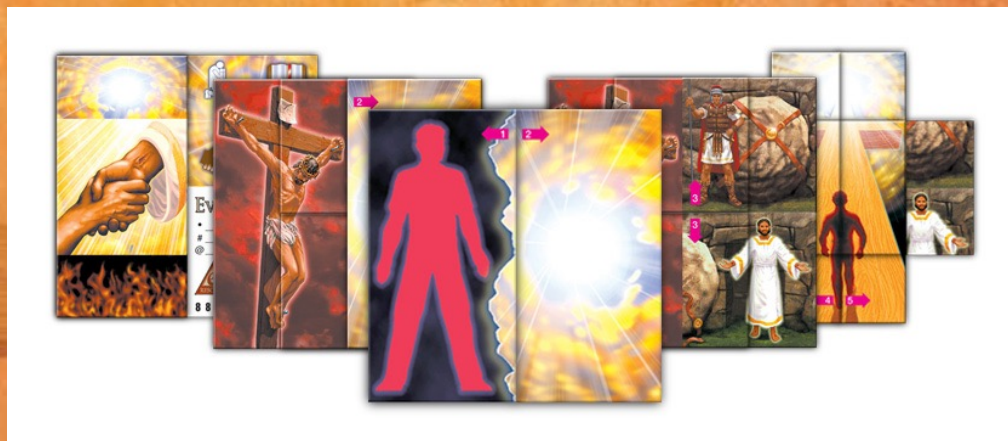
